BERYLLIUM COPPER - THE NEW GOLD?

After shaping, the nibs are heated to high temperature and then quenched in cold water to achieve maximum hardness.

The nibs are then tempered at medium temperature and left to cool in the oven. This achieves the optimum balance between hardness and elasticity



Before tipping and slitting, the nibs are freed from the oxide layer that has formed as a result of heating.

This is done by polishing in a polishing drum with walnut shell granules and a fine polishing paste. This process takes up to 1 week.
